Back to school

The school day is from 8:00 a.m. - 2:45 p.m. Monday thru Friday. Students may be dropped off beginning at 7:15 a.m. and should enter using Door 7W, near the Auditorium.

Students arriving to school late must report to the office to sign in. Students leaving school early for any reason must report to the office to sign out. Please notify the office if your student will be leaving early, as the consent of a parent/guardian is required. Students are never allowed to leave campus without permission from the office. Students arriving to school after 10 minutes into ANY period will be marked absent for that period. Prior to the 10-minute mark, a tardy will be used. Students who leave 10 minutes before the end of any period will be marked absent for that period.

Medication Information

ALL PRESCRIPTION AND NON-PRESCRIPTION MEDICATION MUST BE KEPT IN THE OFFICE, WITH THE EXCEPTION OF INHALERS.

Medication will be administered by office personnel. Students must have a current gold Medication Authorization form on file in the high school office. Without the Medication Authorization form, your student will not be allowed to take any medication at school.

We will no longer have any medication to hand out. This includes Motrin, Tylenol, antacids, cold/allergy medicine, etc. If your student requires any medication, prescription or non-prescription, you must send it in with your student. All medication must be in the original container. All medication will be labeled with the student's name and be kept locked in the office.
