All gifts will need to be returned to school, unwrapped, no later than **Monday, December 5th**.

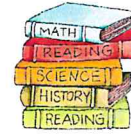

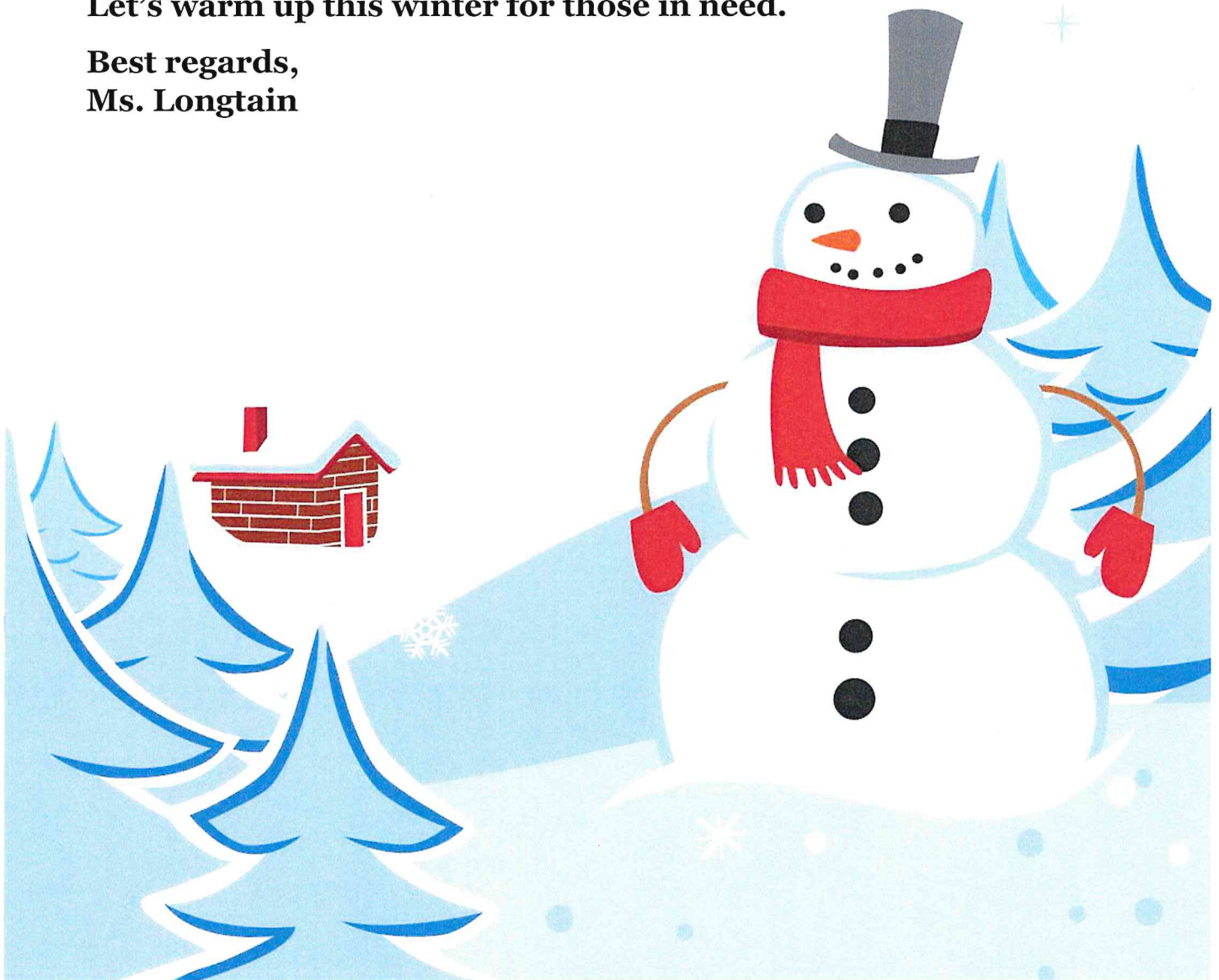


Let's Warm Up the Winter!

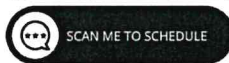
